Marc C. Munder, age 76, a longtime resident of Lake Bluff, Illinois and a Vietnam War Veteran passed away August 2, 2022.

Marc graduated from Zion-Benton Township High School in 1964. After graduating as an honor student from Northern Illinois University, he was drafted into the U.S. Army Corp and sent to Vietnam. He served in Cameron Bay and was awarded the Bronze Star Medal. His first job after the war was as a salesman for the Charles Munder Company, which produced color separations for the printing industry. Later his career turned to marketing and sales of computer systems.

He was a member of the Lake Forest/Lake Bluff Rotary and many business organizations including the Printing Industries of Illinois.

He married Barbara Ann Bonham of Barrington, Illinois in 1979 and they lived in Chicago for several years before moving to Lake Bluff Illinois where they have resided for 39 years.

In his younger days Marc loved to sail and ski. As time moved on he traveled and golfed and loved spending time with his children, their spouses, his eight grandchildren and many friends. His second home in Arizona was a special passion.

Beloved husband of 43 years to Barbara Munder; loving father of Lauren (Kevin) O'Flaherty, Adam (Jacqueline) Munder, and James (Carly) Munder; cherished grandfather of Paige, Owen and Parker O'Flaherty, Evelyn and Nova Munder, Marlowe, Mac, and Lane Munder; brother of Lou Adams, Kris Shryock, and Carol Munder; uncle of many nieces and nephews; and son of the late Charles Rushworth and Ruth Korinck Munder.

Mark 9:14-29 - This is the story of Jesus demonstrating for the disciples that there are certain demons that must only be cast out by fasting.

The Pharisees came and began to question Jesus. To test him, they asked him for a sign from heaven. 12 He sighed deeply and said, "Why does this generation ask for a sign? Truly I tell you, no sign will be given to it." 13 Then he left them, got back into the boat and crossed to the other side.

Beware of the Leaven of the Pharisees and Herod: Mark 8:13

13 And He left them, and getting into the boat again, departed to the other side. 14 Now [a]the disciples had forgotten to take bread, and they did not have more than one loaf with them in the boat. 15 Then He charged them, saying, "Take heed, beware of the [b]leaven of the Pharisees and the leaven of Herod."

Mark was special to the Most High and he has had favor.
