Charles and Daphne were honored to be judges at many national competitions, including The National Horse Show at Madison Square Garden. Charles rode for the United States Equestrian Team. He was inducted into The National Show Hunter Hall of Fame. He was a director of American Horse Show Association.

Beloved husband of Daphne B. Dennehy for 67 years; cherished father of Denise (Frederick III) Lenn, the late Clarke Dennehy and Daphne L. (Brett) Botula; grandfather of the late Kyle Clarke Lenn; brother of the late Wilson Dennehy and Sister Virginia Dennehy.
