



Richard "Dick" Mark Saville Jr.

March 3, 1952 - April 14, 2026

Richard (Dick) Mark Saville Jr., 74, passed away peacefully on April 14, 2026 in Redmond Washington.

Born March 3, 1952 in Evanston, Illinois, he was the beloved son of Richard Mark Saville Sr. and Constance Lewis Saville. He was a great-grandson of Clayton Mark, founder of the Mark Manufacturing Company (1888) an early resident of Lake Forest. His grandmother, Lydia Marie Mark Saville, was the daughter of Clayton and Anna Mark and wife of John Kimball Saville, whose lineage traces to the Mayflower passenger John Howland, a signer of the Mayflower Compact in 1620. Dick grew up in Lake Forest, Illinois graduating from Lake Forest High School and the University of Notre Dame, South Bend, Indiana in 1974 with a Bachelor of Science in Engineering.

Dick moved to Washington State in 1996 with his wife and three young children. He built a career as a software developer at Microsoft and later accepted consulting roles throughout his professional life. With a quick wit, sense of humour and a gift of storytelling he delighted everyone he met. He was an avid chess player and program developer.

Preceded in death by his parents, Richard Sr. and Constance Saville he is survived by his former wife, Darla (Steve) Jackson; his children, Richard (Kim) Saville III, Ryan (Becca Mullen) Saville, and Samson (Grace Poliner) Saville;

his grandson, Shawn Howard Saville. He is survived by his three sisters, Katherine, Constance and Alice; niece Caitlin (Brendan) Collins; nephews, Joseph Walsh and Nicholas Walsh; and grand-niece and grand-nephews, Madeleine Collins, Finnbar Collins, Wallace Walsh, and Jack Walsh.

A Memorial Service and Catholic Mass will be held at St. Patrick's Church (Little Church), 991 Waukegan Road, Lake Forest, on May 29, 2026 at 10:30 am followed by interment at Lake Forest Cemetery.
