



Ts-Ai Marina Lin

November 18, 1931 - August 11, 2020

Ts Ai (Marina) Lin, 88, of Chicago, passed away August 11th, 2020 after several falls exacerbated by severe osteoporosis and difficulty with asthma.

She was preceded in death by her parents: Kai-Tai Lin and Shiu-Chun Wu Lin, her brothers: Chin-Sheng Lin, Hsin-Tseh Lin, Pei-Jen Lin, and Kuang-Huei Lin, and her two older sisters: Shu-Jen Huang and Rai-Chu Wu. She is fondly remembered by her remaining brothers, Song Mau Lin, Huang Sheng Lin, and sisters, Mei Sie Lee, Frances Yeh, as well as many nephews, nieces, and friends.

Ts Ai was born in HsingKang, Taiwan on November 18, 1931. She was an intelligent and talented student. She attended fashion design school after high school where she was especially good at sewing and making clothes. She also worked at the National Taiwan University Hospital Psychiatry Department as an occupational therapist, and National Taiwan University as a librarian around 1960.

She left Taiwan for Japan and Canada before coming to the United States where she got a B.A. in Psychology and an M.A. in Linguistics from Georgetown University. She was fluent in English, Chinese, Taiwanese and Japanese. She also got her master's degree in Library Science from Rosary College in River Forest, IL in 1974. She became a librarian for the University

of Chicago before working for the Chicago Public Library for many years. She also volunteered at the Museum of Science and Industry as well as a women's shelter, Apna Ghar. She was admired for her determination, courage, strength of character, independence, and generosity. She created a scholarship fund to support young women in HsingKang, Taiwan.

She will be cremated and returned to HsingKang.
